Express Rail Link (ERL)

KLIA Ekspres - The KLIA Ekspres links KL Sentral with Kuala Lumpur International Airport located 57km away. This direct high speed rail, with a frequency of 15 minutes, comes with the unique airport services of a city check in service located at KL Sentral, called the Kuala Lumpur City Air Terminal.

KLIA Transit - The KLIA Transit acts as a high speed commuter rail service with a frequency of 30 minutes, stopping at 3 key southern areas of Bandar Tasek Selatan, Putrajaya & Cyberjaya and Salak Tinggi before reaching KLIA.

Rapid KL Kelana Jaya Line

Kelana Jaya Line uses the state of the art driverless system technology. It has designed to meet the demands of a modern city of Kuala Lumpur. The alignment starts from the Kelana Jaya and ends at Terminal Putra in Gombak totaling to 29km in length with a total of 24 stations.

KL Monorail

In addition to the LRT, the Kuala Lumpur monorail system serves major offices and other commercial developments within the city centre. The monorail's 8.6km route with 11 stations is built on an elevated track.

The monorail serves downtown Kuala Lumpur, plying around the city center and various business districts. This efficient intra city service runs from the north at Titiwangsa Terminal, passing through the city's 'Golden Triangle' before reaching the other end at Kuala Lumpur Sentral railway hub.

KTM Komuter

KTM Komuter Trains, which is part of Malaysia's Railway System add an alternative mode of travel within the city. They connect Kuala Lumpur to outlying townships within a 50km radius, namely to Rawang and Seremban, and between Sentul and Port Klang. This rail service plys along 153km of tracks with 40 stations on two lines; the Sentul - Port Klang route and the Rawang - Seremban route which conveniently intersect at Kuala Lumpur Sentral.

Buses

The public bus service in Kuala Lumpur is efficient and covers a wide range of routes, although steps are being taken to constantly improve the services. Strategic bus stops and stations offer passengers plenty of boarding options. Buses are in good condition and fully air conditioned. Designated bus lanes also enable smooth scheduling of bus services for passenger's ease. The bus routes also link to other transportation options like the Light Rail Transit system, KTM train station and taxi stands.

Aboard any public buses below at Titiwangsa Bus Hub and stop at Tawakal Hospital and 7 Eleven bus stop, opposite Shell fuel station.

All Rapid KL bus tickets are **ALL-DAY** tickets. This simply means that you can enjoy unlimited rides on the same service (Local, Trunk, City or Express) and even in different areas for the whole day. This is valid if you are in Klang or even in Ampang, as long as you are on Rapid KL network.
